

## Stirling Equipment Hire Pty Ltd - Damage Waiver Schedule of Fees

### Definitions

Equipment means any item of plant and equipment listed in the Schedule to this agreement including accessories.

Damage means any physical harm that impairs the value, usefulness, or normal function of something.

Damage Waiver means a purchased product that enables you to reduce your financial liability in the event of damage to equipment that you have hired from Stirling Hire, where that damage is not excluded in the Terms & Conditions.

### Additional documents

The terms and conditions of the Damage Waiver are contained within the document "Stirling Equipment Hire Pty Ltd - Terms & Conditions of Hire".

### Important Notice

Damage Waiver is not insurance, but is an agreement by the Owner that the Hirer's liability for damage to the Equipment can be limited in some circumstances only, to an amount called the Damage Waiver Excess.

<b>Theft or Loss Excess</b> Maximum Liability for Theft\Loss	100% cost of replacement including operational costs	Maximum \$5,000	Maximum \$10,000

- If the Damage Waiver is not purchased, or if it is purchased but the Damage Waiver Excess is not paid, the 'No Damage Waiver' option will apply which is the default liability in our Terms & Conditions.
- The Damage Waiver Fee is non-refundable.
- The Damage Waiver Fee is not available to be purchased retroactively.
